

ANTI ABUSE POLICY

VERSION 1.0

1. Abuse

The act of abuse on the domain names include:

- Distributing malware
- Abusively operating botnets
- Phishing
- Piracy
- Trademark or copyright infringement
- Fraudulent or deceptive practices
- Counterfeiting
- Otherwise engaging in activity contrary to applicable law, and providing (consistent with applicable law and any related procedures)

Consequences for such activities including suspension of the domain name.

2. Consequences

The Registrar reserve the right to deny, cancel, or transfer any registration or transaction, or place any domain name(s) on registrar lock or hold, in its discretion, if a domain is found to violate this anti abuse policy, with the aim to:

- Protect the security and stability of the DNS;
- Comply with any applicable court order, laws, government rules and requests of law enforcement;
- Comply with any dispute resolution process;
- Comply with the terms of Registration Agreement;
- Avoid any liability, civil or criminal, on the part of the registrar, as well as its affiliates, subsidiaries, officers, directors and employees;
- Correct mistakes of the registrants with regards to registry TLD domain registration.

The Registrar reserves the right to place upon registrar lock, hold or similar status a domain name during resolution of a dispute.
