

WHOIS POLICY

VERSION 1.0

1. WHOIS Data Collection

- 1.1. Contact information of a domain name is collected by the Registrar and submitted to the Registry in accordance with the procedural requirements of the Registry.
- 1.2. Registrants are informed that their personal information may be made publicly available via the WHOIS service. Registrar will ensure the WHOIS provided is accurate base on latest ICANN WHOIS Accuracy Specification.
- 1.3. Under the Registration Agreement, Registrants allow the Registrar the right to disclose information for the WHOIS service only upon valid reasons.
- 1.4. Registrants are required to verify the WHOIS information within seven (7) business days on receipt of registration, modification or transfer confirmation notice.

2. Disclosure of WHOIS Data

- 2.1. The Registrar shall display the information as required by ICANN in the required format in Registrar WHOIS.
- 2.2. The Registrar will also use the WHOIS information to contact the Registrant for any issues that is relating to their domain name.
- 2.3. WHOIS data may not be used for:
 - a. advertising and/or marketing purposes;
 - b. for support unsolicited communications to any person, by electronic or otherwise;
 - c. spamming or speculative purposes; and
 - d. for commercial purpose; and
 - e. Illegal purposes;
 - f. to support an electronic query process; and
 - g. bulk access to WHOIS data, other than by sending individual queries to the WHOIS database.
